Have fun completing the challenges for this badge.



All proceeds from the sale of the badges will go to the Parva Drain fund.

There are 7 facets to this Ruby Challenge.

All you have to do is to complete one challenge from each facet. When you have completed them send off for the badges - order form at the end.

Facet 1 - Lincs to Minsk

- Make a Belarusian flag using safety pins and beads or Hama beads.

- Try some Belarusian food; rye bread and draniki.

Recipe for Draniki

Ingredients: 800g potatoes
 1 onion
 3 tbsp plain flour
 ½ cup milk
 1 egg
 Oil for frying

Method:

1. Wash and peel the potatoes. Grate them coarsely. Put them in a deep bowl and add milk covering them completely.
 2. Peel the onions, slice into half rings and fry in oil until transparent.
 3. Drain the milk from the potatoes. Press the milk out of the potato mixture. Add fried onions, flour and egg and mix thoroughly.
 4. Heat the oil in a frying pan. Put spoonfuls of the mixture into the pan and fry on both sides until golden brown.
- Play the national game of Bandy (similar to ice hockey) using rolled up newspapers for sticks and beanbags or plastic balls.

Facet 2 - World Centres

- Make and play a board game based on the 4 World Centres.
- Ice biscuits or cakes with World Centre emblems.



- Make and send a Thinking Day card to each of the World Centres.

Facet 3 - Outdoors

- Enjoy a bubble party using your own or a bought mixture.
- Make, decorate and fly your own kite.
- Go on a scavenge walk and collect natural objects. On your return make them into a 'natural' picture.
- Get out and about on a colour walk. How many different colours did you see?

Facet 4 - Healthy

- Play Dicerobics - throw 2 dice, add the numbers and complete the challenge for that score. When complete roll the dice again and continue. Make up the challenges suitable for the ages and abilities in your group.
Examples might be 10 star jumps, rolling a ball between 2 skittles without knocking them over, skip backwards 20 times, etc.
- Think of a healthy food for every letter of the alphabet.
- Make and enjoy seasonal fruit kebabs.

Facet 5 - Get Crafty

- Sculpt a model or person using vegetables or fruit.
- Make and taste a dish using ingredients sourced only from Lincolnshire.
- Create a collage or montage that represents Lincolnshire.
- Make a mini scarecrow.

Facet 6 - Community

- Visit your local police station or fire station and find out how they work.
- Arrange a joint meeting with another unit in your district or division.
- Hold a coffee morning or evening that is open to your local people.
- Plant 40 red flowers in your locality or decorate your meeting place with 40 red flowers.

Facet 7 - Forty

During the course of completing the challenges for the badge, raise some money splitting the proceeds between your own unit and Parva House. Your money making efforts should be based on the number 40.

- Make and sell 40 cakes
- Have a 40minute sponsored silence
- Hold a sausage sizzle and aim to sell 40 hot dogs
- Have a sponsored skip for 40minutes
- Make up a quiz sheet and sell 40 copies
- Make and sell 40 greetings cards
