This years County International Opportunities Day for girls will take place on Sunday 3rd October 2010 at Wings Meadow, from 10.30am to 3.30pm.

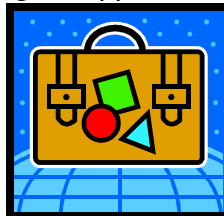
Girls need to be aged 14 - 18 years on 1st November 2010.

Each Division may send 3 girls forward.

Please try to ensure that girls are prepared for selection. Things you may like to discuss with them before hand include; the structure of Guiding - Region, County, Division, District etc, how Guiding began, the origins of the World flag / badge, Chief Guide / President / Patron, the 4 world centres, the link between Lincs South and Belarus etc.

Those girls wishing to attend need to submit the following to their Division International Adviser:

- Anglia International Opportunities Application form fully and neatly completed (available from the Anglia website & International Advisers)
- One Guiding reference on headed notepaper
- Recent passport photo (please do not stick or staple onto form)
- *Please note that the reference from a non-Guiding source (referred to in the Anglia International Opportunities Application form) will only be required by girls that are asked to represent the County at the Region Opportunities weekend*



You may want to organise a Division selection event for your girls during the summer term.

Forms and references for the three girls from your Division that will be attending the County Opportunities day will then need forwarding to me by the **17th Sept 2010** at the latest and earlier if possible.

After our County day four girls will be approached to go forward to the Region opportunities weekend which will be held at Pax Lodge, 26th - 28th Nov 2010. There is also the possibility of a County trip to Minsk taking place next year.
